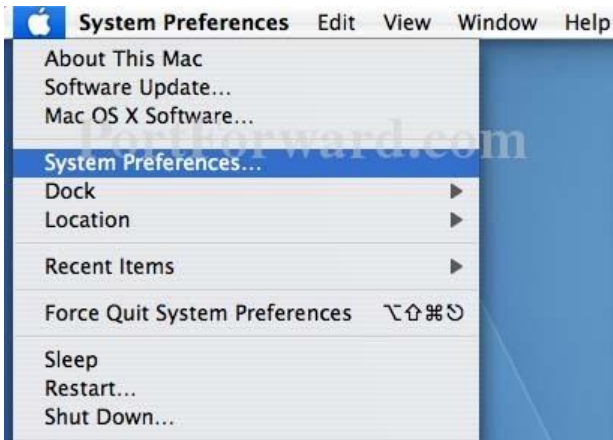


Guide to setting up a static IP on Apple mac

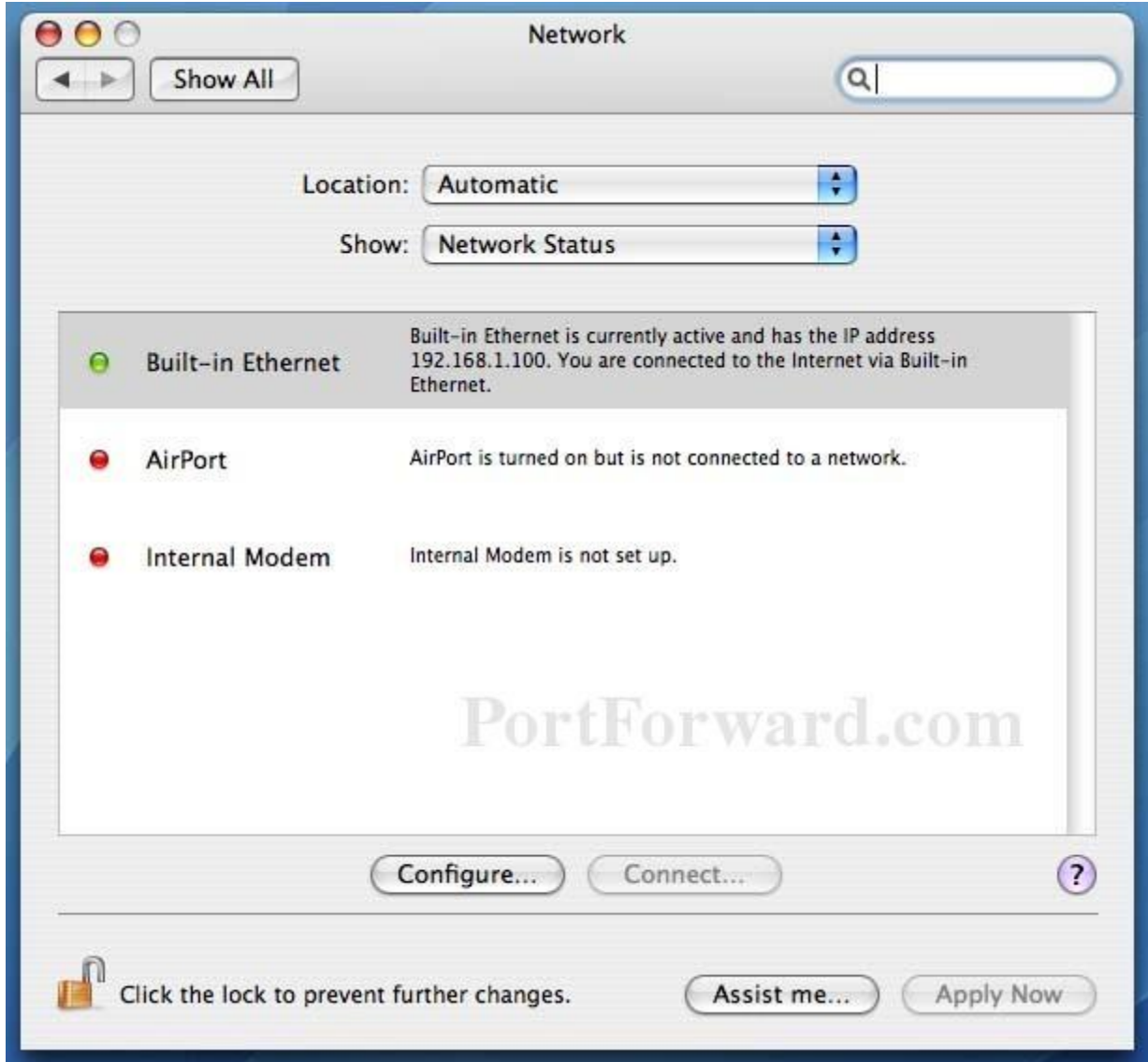
Setting up a static ip for OS X v10.4.



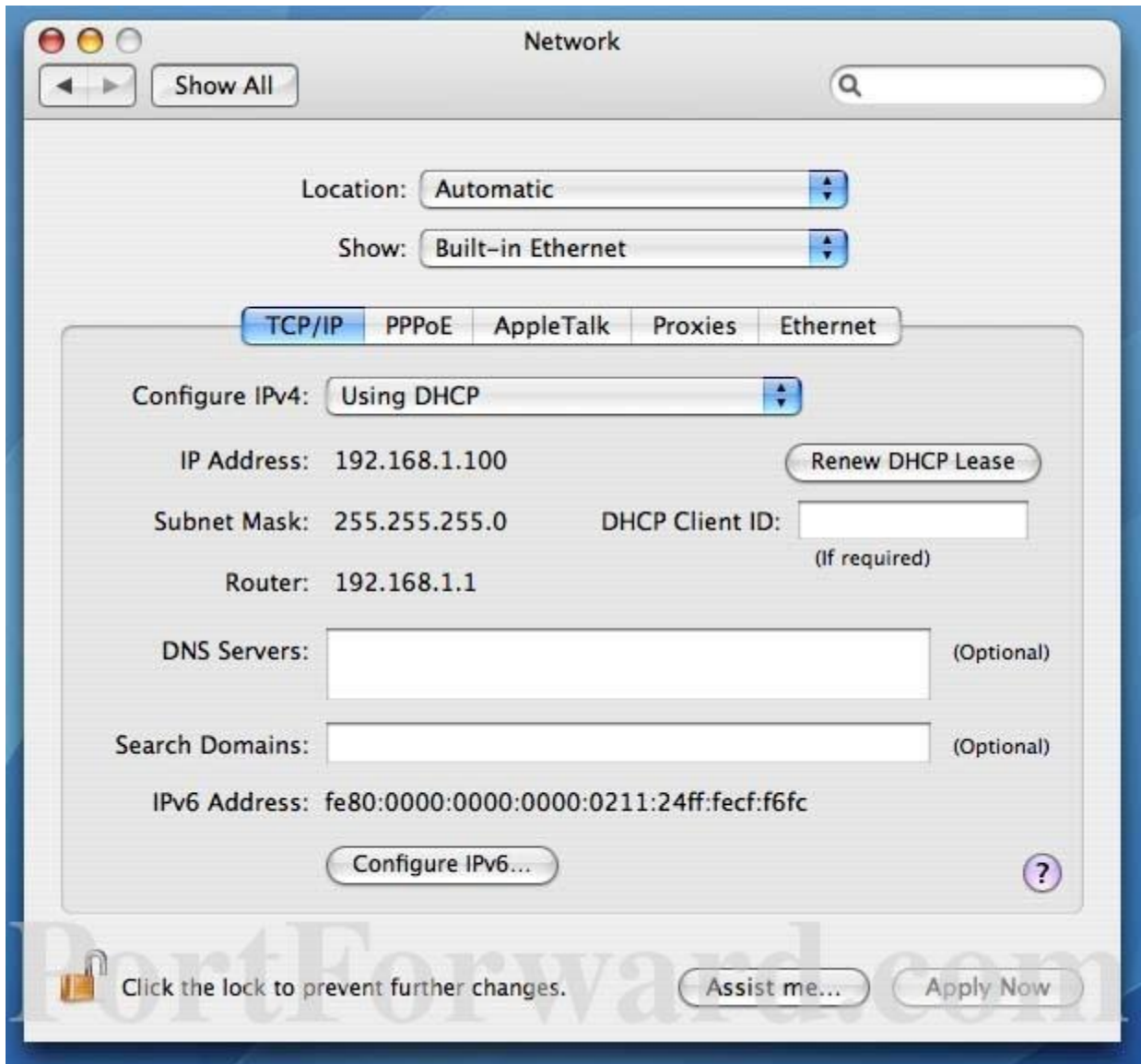
Click the **Apple** icon in the upper left hand corner of your screen. Then click the **System Preferences..** option.



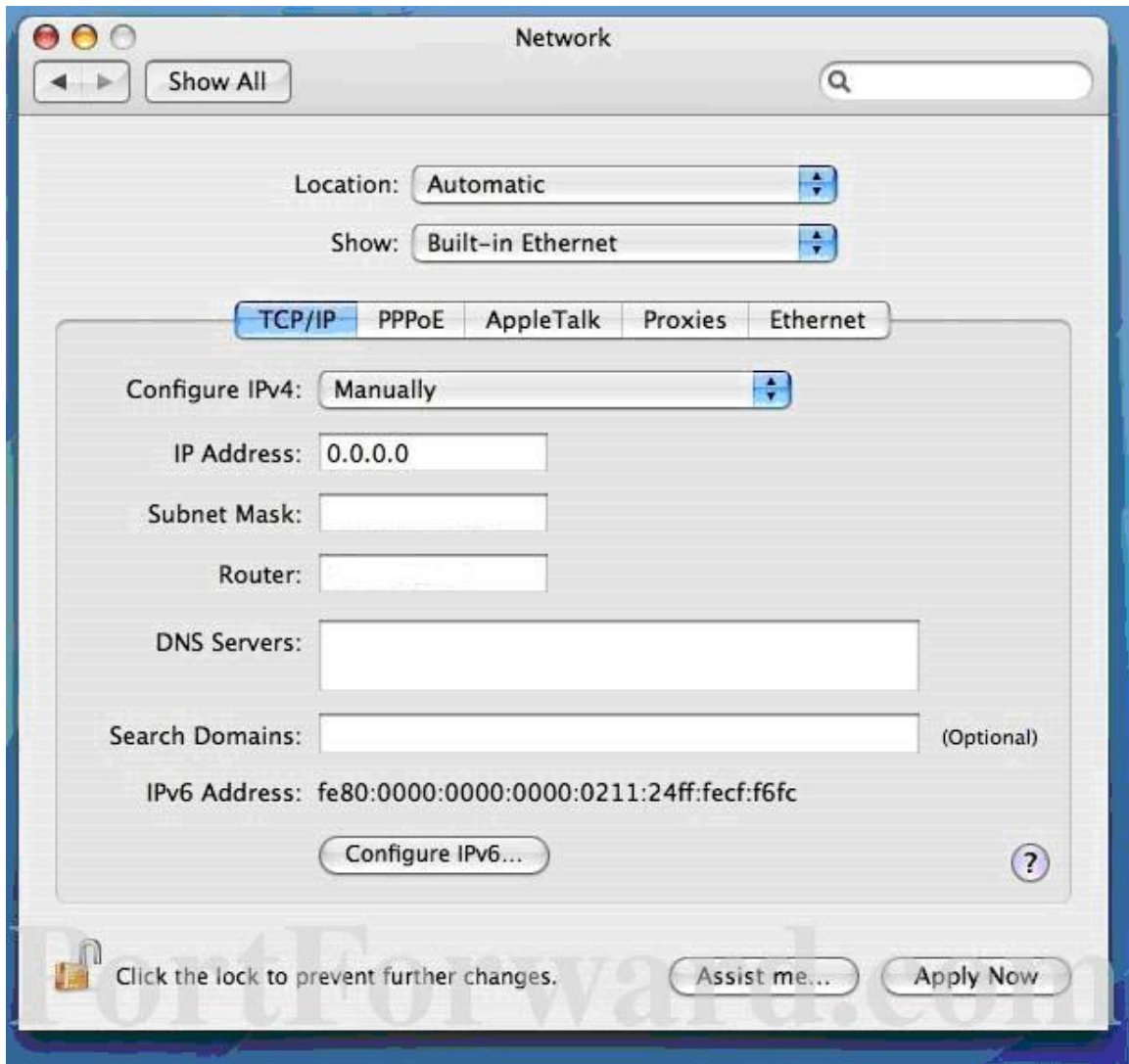
In the **Internet & Network** section click the **Network** icon. You will see the window on the next page.



Select the network connection you use to connect to the internet. It will be the one that has a green dot in front of it. The green dot means the connection is active. Then click the **Configure** button which is close to the bottom of the screen.



Click the **Configure IPv4** drop down box and select the **Manually** option.



Type in the IP information as provided by the management office. Your default gateway will go into the “Router” field.
